

LAND TRANSPORT POLICY 2020

1. LEADERSHIP & COMMITMENT

Mackinnon Construction (MCL) is committed to managing all land transport operations in a safe, healthy and environmentally responsible manner. MCL will lead by example in terms of their own attitude and driving performance and allocate all necessary resources to land transport and related issues, both on and off site. Land transport will be discussed and deliberated at site meetings and briefing sessions to ensure it is considered, cognitive, and managed, in all our undertakings.

Full training and communication will be given to all employees involved in land transport. MCL will provide a safe preventative maintenance system to ensure the safety of drivers and other third party persons.


2. POLICY STATEMENT

- MCL will operate in a safe, efficient and effective manner so as to mitigate accidents and incidents, and operate in an environmentally sensitive and responsible manner
- MCL will continuously strive to improve land transport safety performance by minimising physical risk to our employees and other third party persons
- MCL deem land transport as an important part of our business objectives and recognises that transport incidents are avoidable
- Site management is responsible for implementing and enforcing the land transport policy of Mackinnon Construction and ensuring that employees have an opportunity to consult on such matters and raise any concerns which they may have in relation to land transport safety
- MCL will meet and exceed all required legislative requirements and apply responsible standards and procedures where national regulations do not exist
- MCL will undertake to reduce the consumption of fuel, emissions and discharges and will monitor the use of fuel used by all vehicles
- This policy statement together with a copy of the company's rules for land transport will be issued as a controlled document to all drivers and operators of MCL vehicles and mobile plant. It will be also displayed on the site notice boards
- This document will be reviewed at 12 monthly intervals or when deemed necessary by the Managing Director

3. STRATEGIC OBJECTIVES

The objectives of Mackinnon Construction are to:

1. Reduce the number of accidents and incidents.
2. Minimise the number of journeys and personnel exposure.
3. Minimise the total number of miles driven.
4. Establish driver's selection, testing and training programmes.
5. Establish and support safe land transport working procedures and practices and to strive for an incident free activity.
6. Ensure the company will employ only transport assets, facilities and equipment which conform to acceptable standards and that they are maintained in a safe, secure and operational condition.
7. Specify the need to develop an emergency response capability in cooperation with authorities and emergency services.
